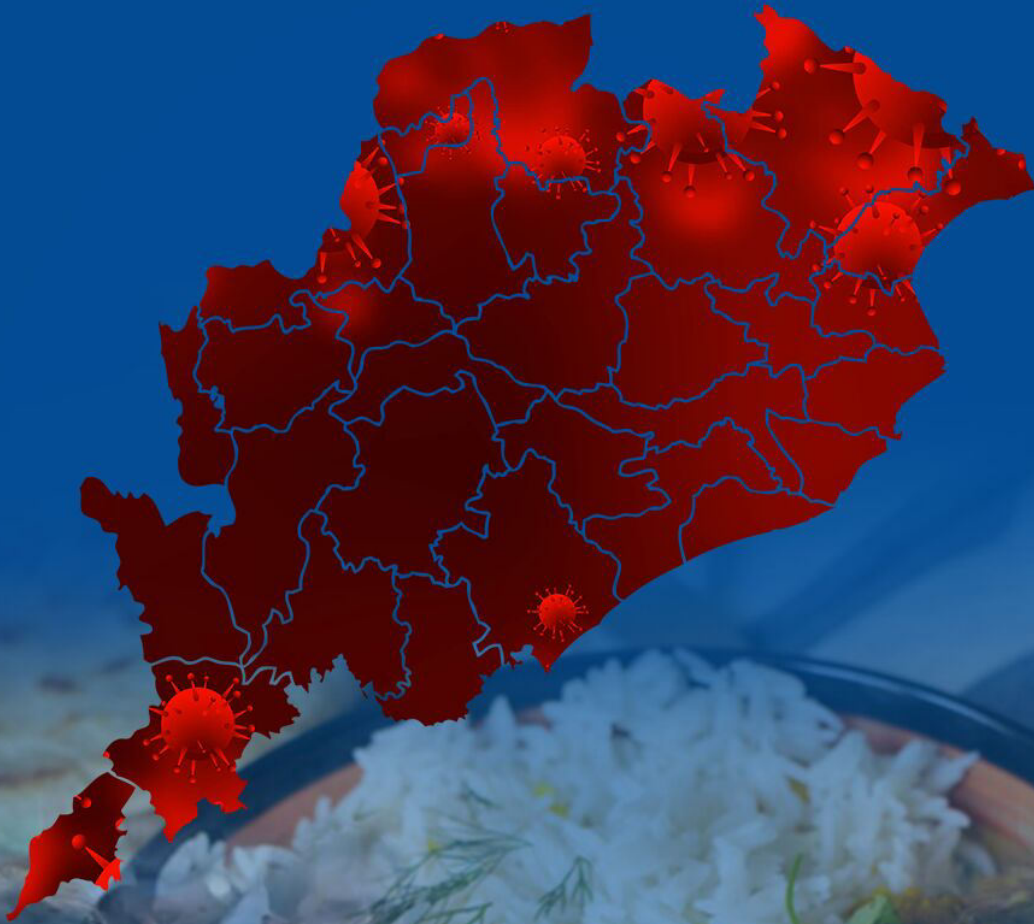

Those in poverty are unevenly distributed across the country with concentration of poverty in some states. In 2004-05, eight states of India accounted for 64.6% of those in poverty. These are Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Bihar Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra, West Bengal and Odisha (Table 3. 4). These states have had a very high proportion of their population in poverty over decades. The incidence of poverty is highest in Orissa at 46.4%.
